

DO NOT DROP OFF THE FOLLOWING ITEMS AT THE YARD WASTE SITE

- **Rubber Tires** – JOHN’S DISPOSAL (888-473-4701) will collect up to **2** per pick up, *as a special pick up*. You may also contact your local tire store/dealership or Kestrel Hawk Landfill (Oaks Road) 884-7097.
- **Recyclables** – Put items in recycle bins. Items include: Glass, Metal, Paper, Cardboard, etc.... (JOHN’S DISPOSAL recommends flattening cardboard boxes to conserve space in the cart)
- **Garbage** – Put garbage in provided garbage cart by JOHN’S DISPOSAL (888-473-4701)
- **Sod/Soil** – It is recommended to call a local landscaper for collection of this, for other options, contact JOHN’S DISPOSAL (888-473-4701)
- **Concrete/Asphalt** – Contact Payne & Dolan (884-9644), they will accept old chunks of asphalt or concrete. Or contact Azarian Wrecking (637-4153), they will accept concrete only. Residents should call ahead to make arrangements to drop-off material. **DO NOT MIX THE TWO MATERIALS.**
- **Batteries** – JOHN’S DISPOSAL (888-473-4701) will collect batteries *as a special pick up*. You may also contact a local battery store regarding trade-ins or disposal.
- **Mattresses/Large Furniture** – JOHN’S DISPOSAL (888-473-4701) will collect these items *as a special pick up*.
- **Railroad Ties** – JOHN’S DISPOSAL (888-473-4701) will collect these items *as a special pick up*, but they **MUST** be prepared as follows: *cut to 1’ or less and bundle and place in containers no larger than 32 inches or 60 pounds.*
- **Lawn Mowers** – Empty out oil/gas, JOHN’S DISPOSAL (888-473-4701) will collect *as a special pick up*.
- **Large Appliances** – It is recommended to call a contractor, or JOHN’S DISPOSAL (888-473-4701) will collect *as a special pick up*.
- **Building Materials** – No loose building materials will be accepted. Construction materials will be accepted if it is in garbage carts no larger than 32 inches or 60 pounds. JOHN’S DISPOSAL (888-473-4701) will collect *as a special pick up*.
- **Paint Cans** – Paint cans with paint still in them should have lids removed and allowed to stand until contents become hard. Add cat litter or sand and paint together inside plastic bag-lined box in order to solidify the paint. The cans may then be placed in the normal trash after drying.
- **Florescent Light Bulbs** – Contact Vans Electric (632-7241) for disposal and current fee or take to the Hazardous Collection site on designated day.
 - Prices for Vans Electric –
 - Up to 4’ = .50¢ each
 - 5’ to 8’ = .65¢ each
 - U-Shaped & Round-Shaped = .95¢ each
